2-Year Schools

4 students maximum – SATB quartet preferred, excellent sight-reading skills required

4-Year Schools

8 students maximum – 2 SATB quartets preferred, excellent sight-reading skills required

Schools with Resident Graduate Singers

12 students maximum, 3 SATB quartets preferred, excellent sight-reading skills required

Important Participation Considerations:

While we would like a balanced choir, we gladly accept incomplete quartets over students who cannot sight-read at a high level. An attempt to send equal numbers of SA and TB would be appreciated. If you have either unbalanced quartets or extra singers (a few), contact Don Trott at dtrott@olemiss.edu . Our goal is to have a powerful choir that reads extremely well.

Participation Fee: \$80 per singer – includes fees to offset clinician, accompanist, music, facility use, concert sessions attendance, waters and two lunches.
